

**NEW BROOKLYN HOUSE OF DETENTION FOR MEN**

**SCHEDULE OF ACTIVITIES \***

**Morning Activities**

**HOUSEKEEPING and PERSONAL HYGIENE:**

Inmates clean their own cells, tiers and blocks. Prepare for breakfast feeding (cafeteria style). Breakfast and pantry clean-up.

**DIAGNOSTIC SERVICE:**

All new admissions oriented to institutional routine and given psychological examinations to determine classification status and type of housing assignment.

**VISITS:**

Attorney and social agency visiting hours — see schedule below: 9:00 A. M. to 4:00 P. M.

**COURT:**

Court recalls and appearances.

**RECREATION:**

Dayrooms — quiet game programs.  
Mobile unit library service.

**COMMISSARY:**

Mobile unit distribution each floor.

**LUNCH: — 11:15 A. M.**

**Afternoon Activities**

**DIAGNOSTIC SERVICE:**

All 16, 17 year olds and first offenders receive individual intake interview by the psychologist or rehabilitation counsellor. *With consent of inmate and parent, individual and group counseling given.* Mental health education period—film and discussion.

**RECREATION:**

Weather permitting, use of open roof area for athletic activities such as, calisthenics, basketball, volleyball, track, etc. During inclement weather — use of indoor gym, library, music. Quiet dayroom activities — reading, chess, checkers, cards, TV. Active dayroom activities — ping pong, Nok-hockey, dart games, others.

**Evening Activities**

**FEEDING:**

Evening meal — 4:45 P. M. Kitchen details. Cafe-

teria style feeding. Meals eaten in dayrooms. Special utility tables used for feeding and recreational functions.

**RECREATION:**

5:45 P. M. to 8:45 P. M.

Roof, gym, dayrooms, library, arts and crafts, music, etc. (see afternoon schedule).

**VISITATIONS:**

Family visits (see schedule below) Worker assigned to visiting room for family contacts.

**Supplementary Activities**

Counseling clinic is open for counseling sessions upon appointment during all activity periods—9:00 A. M. to 5:00 P. M.

Social service assistance. A social investigator routinely available and upon request of inmate or referral from correction officer staff during day. Remedial reading assistance. Small group instruction will soon be provided for individual work.

**Week-End Activities**

**RELIGIOUS SERVICES**

Friday afternoon — Hebrew services  
Sunday morning — Catholic services  
Sunday afternoon — Protestant services  
A. A. meeting — Sunday afternoon

**RECREATION**

Full length feature film entertainment.

**Staff Conferences**

Weekly custodial — by Deputy Warden in charge of program.

Weekly clinical — Youth Guidance staff and departmental psychiatric director. Integrated custodial — clinical — periodically.

**Inter-Agency Contacts**

Cooperation with established courts, Youth Counseling Bureau, probation and parole, Youth Board, churches, schools and community social service agencies.
