- (1) In addition to the regularly scheduled religious services, special services are conducted on religious holy days.
- (2) In addition to the services conducted by institutional Chaplains, volunteer religious workers are permitted into the institution to conduct services and counsel with inmates.

Floor Housing Classification

Inmates are assigned to appropriate floors on basis of reception testing, tests used are: Progressive Matrices, Kent E-G-Y, H-T-P (Projective Drawings).

3rd Floor	Mentally disturbed, acute
4th Floor	Reception
5th Floor	Reception
6th Floor	Mentally disturbed, mild
7th Flr. A-B-C	Drugs
7th Flr. D	Passive homosexuals
8th Flr. A	Aggressive, controlled
8th Flr. B-D	Aggressive, poorly controlled
8th Flr. C	Aggressive homosexuals
9th Flr. A-D	Passive, aged 16 and 17
9th Flr. B-C	Passive, aged 18 and over
10th Floor	Sentenced help

Reception Program for Incoming Inmates Approx. 40 per Day

Day	Activity
1st	Medical exam, body search, fingerprint, shower, property account; assignment to reception floors (4th-5th); inmates from Kings County Hospital and Bellevue, to 3rd Floor.
2nd	Group testing, or, recidivist forms filled out; orientation lecture; diagnostic examination of new 3rd floor inmates.
2nd & 3rd	Intake interviews of 16 and 17 year olds.
3rd	Completion of classification procedures; transfer to housing; pre-psychiatric screening of 6th floor inmates; open-group counseling by floor psychologist.
3rd & 4th	Assignment to closed-group or individual counseling by floor psychologists.
4th	Psychiatric exams of selected screened inmates.

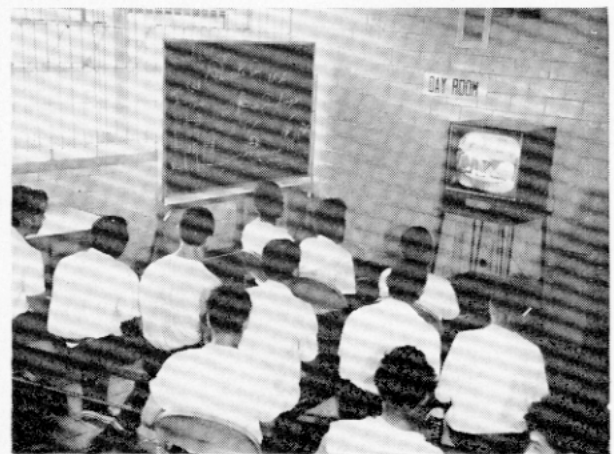
Visiting Schedule
